Sabrina Washington, daughter of the late George McCain and Glenda Hendricks, was born on January 17, 1961 in Haarlem, New York. She departed this life on June 26, 2012 following a courageous battle with cancer.

Sabrina graduated from Louis D. Brandeis High School in 1979. Upon graduation, she enlisted in the United States Marine Corps (USMC) as a food service specialist. She excelled in the USMC, achieving the rank of Sgt. (E-5) in two years, nine months. Her assignments included Parris Island, South Carolina, Camp Pendleton, California, Marine Corps Air Station Iwakuni, Japan, Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, Okinawa, Japan and Marine Corps Base Quantico, Virginia.

During her time in the Marine Corps she received five Meritorious Masts, three Good Conduct Medals, three Certificates of Commendation and multiple Marksmanship Rifle Badges.

Upon receiving an Honorable Discharge from the USMC in 1989, she began working for a small healthcare company while actively pursuing her post-secondary education.

She received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration from the University of Phoenix. She went on to work for numerous healthcare

companies for over twenty years.

Sabrina is survived by: her husband, Bruce; her daughters, Sharida and Kymberley; her son, Jamel; siblings, nieces, nephews, a host of other relatives and friends.
