MRS. SALLIE OLIVER FELDER, daughter of the late Gentry and Hannah Harvin Oliver, was born September 22, 1925 in Clarendon County, Manning, South Carolina. She departed this life on Friday, April 29, 2011 at the Forest Haven Nursing Home in Catonsville, MD.
