Samuel J. Cooper, Jr., son of Samuel J. Cooper, Sr. and Savilla Cole Cooper was born in Baltimore, Maryland and raised in East Baltimore. He would have been 94 years old on November 13, 2017.

He attended and graduated from Paul Laurence Dunbar High School and was attending Howard University in Washington, DC when he went into the Army. Samuel Served in the Army during World War II and was stationed in Germany, where he learned to speak German. He returned home and resumed his education at Howard University and earned a degree in Pharmacology.

After graduation, he worked in two pharmacies, Rostov's and Sach's before becoming Head Pharmacist at Crownsville State Hospital; where he spent most of his career; also teaching student nurses pharmaceutical procedures. After retiring from Crownsville, he worked part-time in the pharmacy at the Walter P. Carter Center.

Samuel was actively involved in the Catholic archdiocese of Baltimore, serving on several boards and committees, including the Urban Commission and the Archdiocesan Pastoral Council; for which he was awarded the Papal

Medal. He was a long-time parishioner of Immaculate Conception Church in Baltimore City.

He leaves to mourn, his sisters, Doris Hill, Carolyn Fugett, Jean Jones and Beverly Cooper; his brothers, Donald Cooper and James Cooper and a host of nieces and nephews. His brother, Robert Cooper, and sisters, Charlotte Sullivan and Elaine White preceded him in death.
