He eagerly fell into his new role as "Daddy" (as Na'Shay affectionately called him) after hearing her mother and aunt address him as such. Samuel began a new career at the Mid-Atlantic Bakery Company and enrolled in the All-American Driving School where he successfully received his commercial driving license (CDL) in September 2008. Sam wanted the best for his family; in addition to bettering his own education he aided his daughter Ashley in receiving her high school diploma. Sammy LOVED to eat! With quite an appetite he frequented Cici's, Golden Corral, and his favorite Cactus Willies Restaurants and looked forward

to the time with his mother. Sammy LOVED us! His mother describes him as happy-go-lucky; his daughter Samantha as very thoughtful, and having the best hugs- big bear hugs; and his nieces Kiarra as “Arthur” as he struggled with his toughness and arthritis in his right arm. He will be sorely missed by all who have known him.
