Samuel Webster Jackson (Sammy/Sam/Toy), son of the late William and Janie (Williams) Jackson transitioned to eternal life on Tuesday, May 16, 2017 after a lengthy illness.

Sam was born on September 28, 1946 and lived in Lacrosse, VA. He attended Nannie V. Boyd Elementary School, Lacrosse, VA and East End High School, South Hill, VA until drafted by the US Army in 1966. While in the United States Army, Sam held many positions stateside and overseas in the field of telecommunications and information technology. Sam served in Communications Operations for 22 years and retired as an Army Master Sergeant in 1988. Within that time frame, he received many awards and accommodations.

After his military retirement he was employed with U.S. Defense Agency, the Department of Interior, and the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) as the IT Network Specialist and the Information Technology Manager for nearly 18 years. During his time with NCUA, Sam earned many work related achievement awards and was recognized as the Staff Support Person of the Year. Surrounded by many friends and co-workers, Sam retired from NCUA in January 2013.

He married the former Bina Aranjelovic, and out of this union two children were born, Sherry (grandchildren Damon and Ian) and Christopher.

Samuel was an active member of his community, residing in Silver Spring. He worked and passionately supported local, state and national political initiatives. He received many accolades from local and state representatives for his work. He volunteered and worked in community outreach program including cancer research and veteran's affairs programs. The staff and students at the Washington Christian Academy and Lynn University were astonished at his level of engagement and concern he always put forth.

Sam truly loved the Lord and attended The Church of Redeemer and was also a former member of Mt. Calvary Baptist Church in Rockville, MD. He loved being with his family, friends, and actively supported our youth. Several of his

other passions included, dancing, attending sporting events, and collecting key chains that would remind him of his travels
