As Mr. Moses health improved he enjoyed taking outings to visit friends at his previous residence, Primrose Place, located at 820 South Caton Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, where prior to his accident he had resided. At Primrose Place, Mr. Moses, was a valued member of the tenant counsel, where after 2 years, the tenant counsel was holding his position open pending his return. Mr. Moses health had improved greatly and he was preparing to move back. On January 18, 2017, Mr. Moses experienced failing health and was admitted to Sinai Hospital and later Season Hospice at Sinai Hospital. His ashes are being presented to his friends at Primrose Place and will have a permanent home, and his eternal home is with our "Heavenly Father".
