Samuel was educated in Union Hall, Virginia and received his high school diploma from the Washington DC school system. In December 1950, Samuel enlisted in the United States Army and served during the Korean War. Upon his discharge, Samuel was employed at Revere Copper and Brass, Harry T. Campbell and Sons, and other positions before retiring and working at BWI Airport as a Sky Cap.

In July 1961, Samuel married the love of his life, the late Margarie LaBoard Baldwin. They were a very affectionate and loving couple. Margarie loved to call Samuel by his pet name "Precious".

Believing no man or woman's life is complete without God, Samuel recommitted his life to God and joined Mt. Moriah Baptist Church after much prayer and the intervention of the Holy Spirit. Samuel loved singing with the Men's Chorus and served as the Recording Secretary for 24 years. He later became a deacon.
