Upon his return, he attended Morgan State University and graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education in 1971. He also graduated from Howard University with a Master's in Music Education in 1983.

An accomplished musician and vocalist, he was known for his tenor voice. He performed at numerous concerts and events displaying his musical talents. He also received many awards for his accomplishments as a teacher, a musician, and vocalist. Samuel then went into business for himself as a music and vocal instructor.

Samuel worked as an educator in the Prince George's County Public School System for many years until retirement, but continued to work as a substitute teacher until his passing.

Samuel drew on his military experience and launched Dominion Security

Services, and worked many contracts in the DC area. He also worked as an investigator for CSOSA. His security company lead him into the DC Public School System as a patrol officer.

Samuel received numerous awards for his company's work.
