



Samuel Leon Winder Jr.

November 14, 1930 - January 18, 2015

Samuel “Sam” Leon Winder, Jr., son of the late Georgianna Mary Donaldson and Samuel Leon Winder, Sr. was born on November 14, 1930 at John Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. He peacefully departed this life on Sunday, January 18 at the age of 84 following a prolonged illness.

Sam received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System. He graduated from Frederick Douglass High School in 1950. Following high school Sam enlisted in the United States Air Force where he served during the Korean War from August 1951 to August 1955. After his honorable discharge Sam enrolled in college and was awarded a Bachelor of Science degree from Morgan State College in June 1961. He completed post graduate studies at Coppin State College.

Following his military service he began a career teaching in the Baltimore City School System. He taught Art to 7th through 12th grade students at Calverton and Herring Run Junior High Schools. He was a very popular teacher. Sam retired in 1984 with 22 years of service. Sam later relocated to White Stone, Virginia where he spent time with family and friends. Sam’s special interests and hobbies were fishing, crabbing, and gardening. He was an amateur radio operator (KB3MR) for more than 30 years.

He was a lifelong member of Mt. Vernon Baptist Church in White Stone, Virginia, having served on the Golden Wing Quartette as a little boy with his brother Donald Winder and the male chorus (Men’s Club) as an adult.

Sam returned to Baltimore to be closer to his children and grandchildren in

February 2013. Some of his favorite times included having Sunday brunch with his brother Dennis “Ibby” Taylor, attending family gatherings, and various outings with his family and friends. His family was his most cherished accomplishment and he basked in the attention of his children and grandchildren. He was happiest when surrounded by his family. Sam left an indelible mark on everyone who knew his laughter and wit and will be remembered for his quick smile and charismatic personality. Sam never missed a birthday and always sent a card.

Sam was preceded in death by his brothers Donald Winder, Robert Tatum, Butch Tatum and William Tatum.
