She later married Carroll Walker who preceded her in death, from that union three step-children: Carroll, Jr., James and La Carroll Walker.

Sandra was a strong woman who battled cancer to the end. Even through chemo-therapy and radiation she still found the time to work with Ms. Theresa, the founder of Ivy Wood Feline Rescue. She provided food for stray cats and

helped them in being spayed, neutered and adopted. She also had a great love for her two cats, Shirley and Bear. She made numerous friends wherever she went.

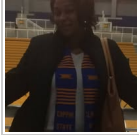

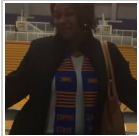
