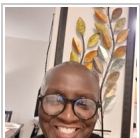

“ While I recognize the miracle that is Sandy's transition to be closer to the God that she so dearly loves and who loves her, it still saddens my soul and spirit to now have to miss her here on earth. Sandy blessed all of us who she met and worked with. I cannot count the positive ways that Sandy brought who she was to make Johns Hopkins, and the world, a better place.

To give just one example of Sandy's amazing impact at the hospital, on a weekend last year, we had a patient in an intensive care unit who, based on his wishes, was coming off life support treatments and was not expected to survive without them. He was surrounded by a loving and incredibly devoted and spiritual family such that, when we were taking him off the life support, we had over 40 people in his room and the adjacent family room. In her role as a chaplain, Sandy came to support this patient and his family at this incredibly emotional time. Sandy's warm, compassionate, and loving spirit just emanated through the room with her words and poise; she provided pure spiritual support and comfort to all there, both patient and family as well as clinician team. While there, she led a bedside prayer and sang one of the patient's favorite hymns as well as led a service of love and commemoration in the adjacent family room at the actual time we were removing the patient from life support.

Sandy gave indescribable comfort to all she met and touched. When I remember Sandy, it will be in thinking of her passion for supporting those around her - particularly her colleagues through being a staff chaplain - and of her vibrant smile that would light up any room she entered. It will also be in remembering how she was that day at that bedside with that patient and family in the intensive care unit - her eyes closed, her head bowed, her hands firmly grasping those of the grieving family around her, her body becoming the apex of a circle of prayer surrounding that patient, and her voice filling the room in a hymn so as to lift up and comfort the patient and all else who cared for him. Sandy will be deeply, deeply, deeply missed at The Johns Hopkins Hospital.
