



Sarah Beatrice Hudnall

November 26, 1924 - February 18, 2008

Life began for Sarah Beatrice Hudnall in rural South Boston, Virginia in Halifax County on November 2, 1924. Surrounded by loving parents, Willie and Hallie Wilson, brothers (Otis Harry, William, John, Ray, James Harvey, Theodore, Willard, Larry, and Earl) and sisters, (Dorothy, Mary Frances, Ruth, Mildred, Willie Ann, Vernell, Jewel, Georgiana, Easter, Lena and Susie). Beatrice acquired a strong foundation in God and family. She graduated from Halifax High School and began her college education in New York City, but returned home to care for her siblings after her mother's death. Shortly thereafter, she met and married Matthew Hudnall and together they raised three endearing children; Elsie, Barbara, and Elvin. Life was always centered around her family and church. Beatrice was baptized as a young adult and became a dedicated member of the S.I. Edwards Memorial Church, currently New Covenant Apostolic Church, where she served as an active member of the missionary board. Caring for her husband, children, grandchildren, and siblings was truly a "passion". "MaBea," "Aunt Bea", and "Grandma" were affectionate titles many called her. Whatever the need, she was always there to support her family and friends, often opening her door and her wallet to give assistance. Residing in Ophelia, Virginia for many years, Beatrice relocated in 1966 with her husband and children to Richmond, Virginia. She was so grateful to be near her church family and siblings. A few years later she became co-owner of the Hudnall's Oil Company and worked diligently with her husband until her retirement in

2006. Beatrice remaining days were spent in the glory of the Lord, with her husband (until he preceded her in death on September 15, 2007), devoted children, grandchildren, and son-in-laws.
