SARAH LEWIS BODDIE was one of ten children born to the union of the late Wiley and Charity Floyd Lewis on May 27, 1915, in Rocky Mount, North Carolina. She received her formal education in North Carolina and was a self-taught pianist, who mastered the scales and traveled throughout North Carolina as well as the state of Maryland, playing music for others. She continued this hobby until 2004.

As a young woman, in North Carolina, Sarah met Samuel Levi Boddie, who union six children were born, Alice, Senora, Betty, Roland, the late Samuel Jr. and David. The loving couple remained married for sixty-eight years until Samuel preceded her on November 11, 2002.

In 1943, the couple relocated to Baltimore, Maryland for better economic opportunities. In Baltimore, she spent many years employed in the food service industry and ended her career at City Hospital. Sarah's vibrant smile, laugh and warm nature was always present when she entertained family and friends who affectionately called her "Ms. Sarah."

At an early age, she accepted Christ as her personal Lord and Savior. Upon relocating to Maryland, she and her family attended Mount Pleasant Baptist Church, now known as Mount Pleasant Church and Ministries. Sarah

remained a faithful member of the church even when she was no longer able to physically attend services.

In 2003, Sarah entered the Future Care Convalescent Home due to decline in health where she remained until her passing on December 2, 2010.
