Sarah moved to New York around 1935. She loved to dance and spent her weekends at the Savoy Ballroom in Harlem. Sarah eventually met Fussler Brown and they married in 1946. He departed this world in 1975. Fussler was a veteran of WWII and served in the Pacific. Sarah worked as a seamstress.

In 1979, she met Larry Thomas and they were companions until his departure from this world in 1988.

Sarah was an active and dedicated member of Union Baptist Church for over 25 years. Sarah read the Bible regularly and even in her 90's would get down on her knees every night to pray.

She moved to Hampstead, Maryland in March of 2004 where she remained until she went home to be with Our Lord on October 7, 2010.
