September 28, 1944 - July 1, 2015

Sarah Jane Hill was born September 28, 1944 in Halifax County, North Carolina to Cephus Hill Sr. and the late Lillie Mae Hill. She was called to rest from her labor and graduated to the church triumphant on July 1, 2015.

Sarah was the oldest of fifteen children. Two of her siblings, Gloria Jean and Barbara Ann, preceded her in death.

The family moved to Baltimore in 1960 when Sarah was the tender age of 16. She finished her education in the Baltimore City Public School System.

she was later married, and had six children. After raising her children, Sarah went to work as a chair-person and activist for families of O'Donnell Heights, for over 10 years.
