She graduated from Dunbar Senior High School. In her young life, she worked at several jobs and continued her education that afforded her the opportunity to be employed by the State of Maryland. She retired as a supervisor from the Department of Transportation. With over 25 years of exemplary job performance.

After retirement, Sarah assisted her daughter in raising her grandchildren, Waverly and Deon. She volunteered at the Edmondson Heights Elementary School for several years. She raised her niece Chantelle as if she was her own daughter. She knew the importance of receiving education and prepared them to be employed, respected and productive citizens.

After being diagnosed with Dementia/Alzheimer's, Sarah moved in with her

daughter Deborah, who became her care provider. Although she was living with her disability, she kept her sense of humor and she interacted with her grandchildren daily. Whenever family members visited and departed, her last words were "God Bless".
