Scott was motivated to do the same. He went on to complete his real estate education and became a licensed agent.

Scott was an entrepreneur at heart, just like his mom, and had a love for older

homes. He established a real estate development business, where he purchased, renovated and sold homes in the Baltimore and Atlanta metro regions. He had a vision of establishing a family owned and operated real estate development company and was actively working towards relocating to Atlanta with his fiancé Limesha to fulfill this dream.

Above everything, Scott valued family. His mom instilled this in him at a young age. After her passing, it became Scott's mission to carry this leadership role in her honor. On a regular basis, he reminded the younger generation of the importance of picking up where his parents, aunts and uncles left off so that we could work together to connect the family.

In January of 2008, Scott became the proud father to Jordan Henson. As a newborn, Jordan was the spitting image of Scott's mother, Vicki. Jordan changed Scott's life forever. His son was always on his mind and Scott spoke about him often. His deep love for his son inspired him to expand his career goals as he wanted to build a financial nest egg for Jordan's future.
