He was engaged to be married to Laura Long on May 26, 2011. They conceived a son, Sean D. Gamble, Jr. (Mook). Sean really was a good provider for his family.

Sean, his siblings and cousins, when growing up, would play WWE wrestling in their living room. They would sit around the table laughing and talking about any and everything. They also made up a song for their mom, "Mommie ". While their father would be sleep, Sean and his siblings and cousins would put paper in his ears and sit back and laugh.
