Sean Dorian Johnson, beloved son of Sean Johnson and Shawnta Little, was born at 8:26 am on July 29, 1998 in Baltimore, Maryland. He is affectionately known as “ Lil Sean” by his family and loved ones.

Sean was a 7th grader at Montebello Elementary Junior Academy under the leadership of Dr. Camille S. Bell, where he attended for all but one year of his academic tenure. He was a thriving student that always worked hard at whatever the task was before him. He was loved by his teachers and friends at school and over the years became very adjusted. His teachers, neighbors and friends often describe Sean as a quiet yet respectful young man with a sense of humor made good decisions and acted as a role model for many who knew and admired him.

Sean was the apple of his mother and father's eyes. He was loving, kind, and always helpful. He absolutely adored his 7 month old brother Me ' Sean and Protected him whenever he felt that he could be in potential danger, even if it meant him climbing up the stairs at home, or visiting the doctor. He took his role very seriously.

Sean also loved both watching and playing sports. Sean began playing football at the age of 9, under the leadership of Gary Best. Before his untimely passing, he was a member of the Lake Clifton Longhorn Football Team where

he was learning to be a Runner Back on the team. He was determined to “play with the big boys” and practiced very hard to make the advance squad.

Johnson leaves to cherish his memory: his mother and father, Shawnta Little and Sean Johnson; two sisters Tamika and Keaunea; and five brothers, Dominique, Devin, Kysean, Kenyon, and Me'Sean; two grandmothers, Lean Little and Lavern Johnson; a grandfather, Myron Johnson, and many other family members and friends.
