Peacefully, on the morning of Saturday, May 18, 2013 Seth Couser departed from his earthly home, and entered into eternal rest. Seth was born November 12, 1926, to the late Mattie Coker-Couser and the late Henry Couser in Edenborn, German Township in Fayette County, Pennsylvania. He had five siblings, brothers: Eugene, Jonathan, and David "Babe" (deceased), two sisters: Virgilee Couser Fulwood and Rovenia Couser Holmes both deceased.
