



## Shallie B. Marshall

July 20, 1932 - November 6, 2012

SHALLIE BARRETT MARSHALL was born in Baltimore, Maryland on July 20, 1932 to the late Grace Brooks and Clarence David Barrett. She had one brother, William E. Brooks who preceded her in death in 1985. She departed this life early at 1:35 a.m. on Tuesday, November 6, 2012 after a brief illness.

Shallie graduated from Frederick Douglass High School, Class of February, 1950. She continued her education in New York, receiving her Registered Nurse Degree at Rockland State Hospital in 1952. Later she was awarded a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from the University of Maryland in June, 1950. She was also awarded a Master of Public Health Degree from Johns Hopkins in May, 1971 and a Master of Nursing Degree from Catholic University in June, 1972.

Shallie worked as a Psychiatric Head Nurse at the University of Maryland Psychiatric Unit from 1958 until 1962, when she joined her husband, Michael in Germany. Upon her return from Germany, she worked at the National Institute of Mental Health in Rockville, Maryland until she retired in 1989.

Shallie loved to travel with Michael to Cancun, Mexico twice a year. They traveled around the world to Europe, Asia and Africa.

She served as Eucharistic Minister at St. Pius Church and received the

Mother Maryland Leadership Award from the Archbishop of Baltimore in 2003.

She loved playing pinochle and the Mexican domino game. Her vivacious and generous spirit was inspirational to all who had the pleasure of knowing her, especially the Beta Wives and the Electra Chapter, No. 1 O.E.S., P.H.A.
