Obituary

Sheldon Clifford Gary, age 60, was called home on September 27, 2022, when he passed away at VCU Hospital in Richmond, VA. He is the son of Elaine G. Gary and the late Clifford Gary. Sheldon was born in Chester, PA on February 5, 1962, the younger of two children.

Sheldon was a former member of Murphy AME Church in Chester, PA. As a child, he was active in the Youth Choir and a delegate to the summer Christian Education Program.

Sheldon grew up in Wilmington, Delaware, and graduated from Howard High School in June 1980. In his senior year, he was elected Class Treasurer, one of four class officers. Sheldon had perfect attendance in his junior and senior years, an achievement that he was enormously proud of.

Following graduation, Sheldon Gary enlisted in the United States Navy on September 5, 1980, and served his country proudly as a communications specialist until September 4, 1984. He was in the Navy Reserve from January

24, 1985, to November 22, 1989, and received an honorable discharge from the Navy Reserve as well.

Sheldon Gary was united in holy matrimony with Leslie Sherree' Hawthorne, the love of his life, on May 5, 2001, in Richmond, VA. Their family was blessed with four children: Spencer Gary, Stephen Gary, Taenika Penny, and Tyrese Xavier Gary.

A conscientious and dedicated worker, Sheldon became a supervisor in 2020 at the communications center of Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) Hospital in Richmond after working there for five years. He was exceedingly loved and respected by his fellow workers. Sheldon was also a people person, and several of the workers he supervised spoke glowingly of the warm atmosphere he created and his cheerful character. He was a mentor to several workers who turned to him for both professional and personal advice. He was particularly proud to be a mentor to several struggling young men. Outside of work, loved ones and friends often commented that his energy, smile, laughter, and personality could light up a room and quickly change a bad day into a great one. He always made time to support his children and family in everything they did by providing an encouraging word and/or presence. He valued hard work, honesty, and was always a man of his word. Sheldon was a great humanitarian who decided to become an organ donor after witnessing great need at his job at VCU. The family is proud to have honored his wishes at the end of his life.

In his spare time, Sheldon enjoyed reading, watching sports (his favorite football team was the Eagles), cooking, and spending time with loved ones. He was a true blessing to others and family, friends, along with co-workers would describe him as loving, protective, knowledgeable, motivated, suave, giving, generous, helpful, a go-getter, friendly, fun, respectful, and a provider to those around him.

He is survived by his loving and devoted wife Sherree' and his children, who were the light of his life: Spencer, Stephen, Taenika, and Corporal Tyrese, and godson Josiah "Jo-Jo" Thompson. Sheldon is also survived by his mother,

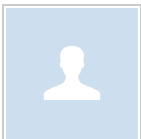
