



## Sherman Bass Jones

November 1, 1942 - November 9, 2017

Trustee Sherman B. Jones, at the age of 75 transitioned from labor to reward in the afternoon on Thursday, November 9, 2017 in the privacy of his home surrounded by his family. Sherman was born on November 1, 1942 in Norfolk, Virginia to the late Willie (adopted father) and Vernice Jones. He was united in Holy Matrimony to Brenda Bond on April 13, 1972.

Trustee Jones accepted Christ as his personal Savior at an early age because of the influence of his grandmother as he walked her to church on Sunday. He and his family relocated to the Richmond area, where he became a faithful and active member of the First Union Baptist Church in Mechanicsville, Virginia under the leadership of Rev. Dr. Bernard Giles, Sr. He served as a dedicated member of the youth, video, music and trustee ministries. During his later years (even until his health began to fail) he continued in loving fellowship with his church and sincere commitment to the Lord. In 2016, Sherman's trustee service was celebrated by the Trustee Board as Trustee Emeritus. He had many hobbies such as fishing, cooking (especially Thanksgiving dinner), and rooting for the Washington Redskins.

Sherman worked for Federal Express over 15 years with Jerrod Brooks, Jessie Howard and Robert Young. He continued to provide for his family over the next 10 years as sole proprietor of the Jones Delivery Service, LLC until he retired. Trustee Jones served honorably in the United States Army.

Trustee Jones was a devoted son, husband, father and friend. He leaves to cherish his many memories, his loving and devoted wife of 45 years, Brenda

Jones; two children, Cedric Jones and Bryan Bond; goddaughter, Brianna Howard; two sisters, Angie Hunt Geth and Cynthia Hunt Dessult of Norfolk, Virginia; two brother, Eugene and George Jones (preceded him in death),and a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.
