Sherron Yolanda Bogues was born on July 14, 1960 in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Richard Bogues Jr. and Elaine Bogues. She was called to her heavenly home on July 28, 2015 after her battle with cancer. At a young age, Sherron gave her life to Christ and recently renewed her relationship with Him.

Sherron received her education in the Baltimore City Public School System and graduated from Paul Laurence Dunbar in 1978. She went on to further her education at Community College of Baltimore and Towson State College. While attending college she began her lifelong career with the Baltimore City Department of Recreation and Parks. Through her success as a Recreation and Parks professional, she excelled to the position of Program Director of Youth and Adult Sports. Sherron served twenty-nine plus years in this position. She had a fond love of sports especially basketball. Sherron helped pave the way for many youth and adults through programs such as BNBL, Project Survival, and the Holiday Tournaments. She was instrumental in collaborating Recreation and Parks football league with Pop Warner. As a result of her great work in Baltimore City, Mayor Stephanie Rawlings-Blake declared June 27th, 2015, "Sherron Bogues Day."

Sherron had a love for children especially her nieces and nephews. She also enjoyed dancing, bowling, as well as playing bingo.

She leaves to mourn: three brothers and two sisters-in-law, Richard Bogue, Anthony Sr. and Colleen Bogue, and Tyrone Sr. and Kimberly Bogue; four nephews, Rachard, Anthony Jr., Tyrone Jr., and Tanodrio; four nieces, Sherwan, Tyisha, Brittney and Malissa; four great nephews, Sarmartine, Kumari, Jailen, and Chandler; four great nieces, Kneaira, Taniya, A'mya, and Saige; stepson, James Field Jr.; eight aunts, seven uncles, two great aunts, and three special friends, Jimmy, Myrt, and Gloria; and a host of other relatives and friends.

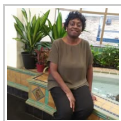
