In hopes of greater economic opportunity, her family relocated to Baltimore in the late 1940s. Shirley was accompanied by her oldest sister Sarah Finney and later joined by the rest of her maternal family in the early 1950s.

She received her education in Baltimore City Schools, graduating from Carver Vocational High School in 1958.

Her love for adventure and Edward Jones resulted in relocating yet again. Bermuda became her primary residence for a number of years. She inspired, influenced and developed friendships here that would last a lifetime.

Once back in the states, she resumed employment at the Shock Trauma Center, University of Maryland of 25 years until her retirement in 1998. After retirement she took on the role as caregiver for her mother until her passing in 2001. She was always a devoted daughter, mother, grandmother, sister, and aunt. The epitome of style, grace, class, and sophistication is what describes Shirley even while battling her short term illness.
