Shirley Mae Harris was born to the late Klutz Wilks and Florence Chisholm Wilks on August 8, 1941 in Chester, South Carolina. She departed this life on July 15, 2015 following a recent illness.

Shirley received her education in the Baltimore City Public Schools, graduating from Carver Vocational High School in the Trade of Cosmetology. Upon completion of high school, she was licensed as a Cosmetologist and began her apprenticeship. Soon after, Shirley became an entrepreneur by purchasing her own salon: Shirley's Gateway to Beauty. Shirley went on to receive a Doctorate of Cosmetology from the National Beauty Culture League INC University. She also received many awards in her field and is respectfully known as Doctor Shirley Harris. Dr. Shirley Harris served in her profession both as a State Board Examiner and an Educator in the field of Cosmetology.

On January 26, 1964, Shirley was united in Holy Matrimony to Robert Mosley Harris, also of Baltimore, Maryland and from this union, two sons were born, Robert Harris Jr. (Bobby), and Jace Harris.

She loved to showcase her talent and played at many recitals.
