Shirley Ann Peoples, daughter of the late Joseph and Nellie Harris was born July 18, 1943, in Richmond, Virginia. She entered eternal rest on Friday, May 27, 2022.

Shirley was educated in the Richmond Public School system and graduated from Maggie L. Walker High School in 1961.

Shirley retired from Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield after twenty-five years of service as a Medical Claims Processor for the Commonwealth. She was recognized for her outstanding work ethic, quality of work and dedication to helping her co-workers.

Shirley confessed Christ as her Lord and Savior as a child, in 1952 at Ebenezer Baptist Church. She attended Sunday School and was a member of the Junior Missionary Circle.
