SHIRLEY BELL RAMSEY, the daughter of the late Rosa Thomas and Richard Anderson, was born on August 30, 1943 in Florence, South Carolina. God called Shirley to her eternal rest on Monday, January 23, 2023.

She was raised in Florence, where she worked and took care of her younger siblings at an early age. She then relocated to Baltimore, Maryland in the early 60s, by way of New York. She became a faithful member of the Mt. Zion Apostolic Faith Church under the witness and teaching of Bishop Edith A. Mangum. She married Levi Miller II; after a short marriage, she later married James Ramsey Sr. until the time of his passing.

She went back to school and received her GED in the early 70s, she also began working diligently for the Social Security Administration around that same time until she retired. She served on multiple ministries at the Mt. Zion Apostolic Faith Church where she served as a missionary, secretary, on the kitchen committee and sang on the church choir for decades.

Shirley, also known as Rambo, had a love for the finer things in life. She loved jewelry, sweet smelling perfume, trips and loved to have good

times with family and friends. She always poured positivity and wise words into young men and women often giving them life advice and telling her story of her rough upbringing.
