On February 24, 1937, the sun rose in Baltimore, Maryland, on SHIRLEY GRACE WHITE, daughter of the late Carrie E. Wilson and Isaiah Wilson. Shirley White passed away on Monday, September 23, 2013, at Union Memorial Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland.

Shirley, affectionately called “Shirley” or “Miss Shirley” by family and friends, is preceded in death by four sisters Estella Pinder, Bernice Thompson, Lillie Mae Cooper, Thelma Carter, and two brothers Donald Hall and Isaiah Wilson, affectionately called “Poppy.” She was raised in Baltimore and attended the Baltimore City Public Schools. Shirley served as a Nursing Technician at South Baltimore General Hospital for thirty-five years, before retiring in 2001.
