SHIRLEY ANN WOOD was born in Richmond County, Virginia on June 18, 1941 to the late George and Dorothy Brown. She peacefully departed this life on December 26, 2020 at Sinai Hospital. Shirley was the only sister to two brothers; George Brown Jr. preceded her in death. She received her high school diploma from Richmond County High School. Shirley accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Galilee Baptist Church in Montross, Virginia.

On May 25, 1968, Shirley married the love of her life, James A. Wood Sr., becoming a stepmother to two sons, James Jr. and Michael. They settled in Baltimore, Maryland where she remained a loving housewife for fifty-three years.
