



## Sidney Douglass Lee

December 13, 1924 - December 16, 2001

Sidney Douglass Lee, son of the late Jacob and Mary Lee, was born on December 13, 1924 in Baltimore, Maryland. Sidney departed this life on December 16, 2001 after a lengthy illness. Serving in the United States Army in World War II interrupted his education. As a staff Sgt. he received an E.A.M.R. Campaign Medal with four bronze stars, a Good Conduct Medal, a Victory World War II Medal for service from June 29, 1943 until January 3, 1946. Upon leaving the service, he went to work as a maintenance man for the Housing Authority of Baltimore City and retired after thirty years. He married the late Mary Lee in 1945, and out of this union six children were born. Sidney made numerous friends wherever he went and will be sincerely missed by everyone who knew him. He was always a true friend and a devoted family man. Sidney leaves to cherish his memory and continue on with life: a devoted sister, Dorothy; two daughters, Clara and Roslyn; four sons, Donald, Richard, Sidney and James; two daughters-in-law, Theresa and Christine Lee; one sister-in-law, Elizabeth Butler; fifteen grandchildren (two preceded him in death), twenty-five great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and a host of other relatives
