July 5, 1952 - January 1, 2020

Silas A. Young was born July 5, 1952 to Helen E. Robinson Young and the late William F. Young Sr. Silas was the 3rd son born from their union. After a lengthy fight with his illness Silas waited for the new year (2020) to gain his wings.

Silas was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. He attended Coppin State College, where he met the love of his life Janice Duckett. That union produced their son Maceo De'Are.

Silas became the first black toll collector while he was in school, although he lied about his age. He also worked as a Correctional Officer at the Maryland House of Correction in Jessup (The Cut) for 20 years. Silas left "The Cut" to work at the Baltimore Transit System now known as the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) for 28 years. After repeated illnesses at work in 2016, Silas took a medical retirement. His last position before retiring was as a station attendant.

Silas left Baltimore to relax at his home in Princess Anne, Maryland. In February 2017, Silas broke his hip. After his surgery, Silas asked his favorite nephew, Billy to bring him back home to Baltimore. Silas stayed with Billy and Sabina until the early morning of January 1, 2020 when he received his wings.

Silas leaves his son, Maceo De'Are; mother Helen Young; brothers Larry Curtus (Vivian) of Ohio; Martin Blaine (Tammie) of Baltimore; Ronald Maurice (Kizzy) of Delaware; sisters-in-law Barbara Melvania, Francesca, Lucinda, 1 uncle Richard Robinson, 13 nieces, 10 nephews, and his partners Krayon (Kayen) and R. Kelly (Kelly), lifelong friends Arvis Harvey, and Cornelius Hall. Co-workers: Avon Johnson, Baylis Irby, Anthony "Big Country" Nichols, and a host of other family and friends.
