SIREN ANJANETTE DAVIS, daughter of Stanley Davis and the late Lorette Jenkins Davis, was called Home by her Heavenly Father on Sunday, October 2, 2022.

Siren was born on January 5, 1982 at Eglin Air Force Base in Florida where her father served in the military. Shortly afterwards, the family relocated back to their hometown of Baltimore, Maryland where Siren blossomed into a beautiful soul. At the early age of ten, she professed faith in Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior and was baptized in His Name while a member of the Obedience Church of God.

Siren attended primary public school in Baltimore City and progressed to private middle school at Perry Hall Christian School in Baltimore County. At Overlea High School in Baltimore County, her talents and enthusiasm for the performing arts emerged when she debuted in the starring role of Dorothy in the school's extraordinary production of "The Wizard of Oz"! She went on to receive her high school diploma from Fairmount Harford High School in Baltimore City.

Following high school, Siren showcased her vocal skills while entertaining tourists by belting acapella R&B tunes at "The Fudgery", the singing fudge shop at Harborplace in downtown Baltimore. She continued to refine her

talents by auditioning for and joining various performance arts venues where she made many friends and professional contacts. Her endearing personality brought joy to the lives of many through spirited impromptu performances. Most recently, she joined the Saint Demetrios Suburban Players and took the role immortalized by Whoopi Goldberg as Deloris Van Cartier in their production of "Sister Act – The Musical".

Her many other interests included a great love for karaoke and an burgeoning interest in photography. She was also employed in various positions as an office assistant and receptionist.
