After a lengthy illness, STANLEY CLIFTON HARRIS departed this life on April 10, 2019, at the age of 78. After graduating from Douglass High School, Stan served in the United States Army, receiving an Honorable Discharge. Stan took fashion cues from no one. His signature look was khaki pants, a plaid shirt, and tam hat. Stan was an avid reader who enjoyed fishing,

horseracing and playing pool. He considered himself the 'Minnesota Fats' of Baltimore. In recent years, Stan socialized at the Zeta House, where he feasted with friends and vacationed to various destinations. While at the Zeta House, Stan developed a fondness of modern technology that resulted in him attending computer classes.
