Then, a year and four months later she had her second beautiful baby girl, Sheeriece Ellie-May Samuel. She was born on March 10, 1992. Their biological father is Davon Corbin. At the age of thirty, she was married to Michael George Campbell, June 15, 2002. In 1996, Stephanie Samuels came to the United States of America, where she obtained her Associates degree in Computer, after which she was employed at the Washington Hospital Center. Then she had a job change to Verizon where she worked until her illness, which carried her to meet her Heavenly

Father on December 14, 2004.
