Upon graduating from Armstrong, he entered the United States Navy where he served from 1955 – 1959. He served aboard USS Ticonderoga CVA-14 in the Pacific Fleet. His discharge rank was Petty Officer 3rd Class.

Stebo accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Bethlehem Baptist Church on July 1, 1955. As a member of Bethlehem Baptist Church, he served with the Male Chorus for 52 years and was President and Director for 5 years; Chairman, Music Committee (5 years); Chairman, Men’s Fellowship Hospitality Committee (5 years); Chairman, Together We Build Hospitality Committee (5 years); member of Randolph Memorial Choir for 10 years and he was a member of the Food Service Ministry. He was also a member of the Celebration Male Chorus under the direction of Dr. Willis Barnett.

Stebo was employed by the United Postal Services for many years. After leaving the postal service, he was hired to work at the Boys Club of Richmond where he retired after 38 years of service.

Stebo loved his family and friends. He was always helping anyone who needed help. He enjoyed cooking, singing and his family. He became a Mason at Henrico Lodge #41. Stebo loved so many things, but most of all he loved the Lord.
