It stayed with him, but he was able to teach school for a while. He had to stop teaching because of his war-related illness.

Steven was a kind and loving person and was always ready to help whenever he could. He attended the local church when he was able to do so. Steven talked about how he prayed about the war trauma. He liked Bible classes at church.

He leaves to mourn: his mother; his ex-wife, Cynthia; sister, Carolyn Adams; brother, Ronald Doswell; nephew Jayfus Doswell; two nieces, Tracee McClain and Charlene Adams; aunt, Lois Smith; as well as many cousins and friends. He will be missed.
