April 21, 1924 - April 25, 2015

Susan Ellen Manning was born in Lane, South Carolina on April 21, 1924, a daughter of the late James W. and Bertha (Peanute) Williams. She entered her final resting place on Saturday, April 25th, 2015 at her home after an illness.

She received her formal education in the Lane Public Schools of Williamsburg County. She relocated to Baltimore, MD in 1947 where she joined United Baptist Church; her relationship with United Baptist Church was a driving force in her life.

She expressed the following words in the souvenir journal of 2003..."I joined United Baptist Church in September, 1948, when it was located at 1210 Lexington Street. I was baptized in May, 1949. When I left South Carolina, my mother told me not to run the streets but to find a church home. I just love United and I love my Pastor. United Baptist UBC has been an influence in my life. I love listening to my Pastor preach. I love the members and the choirs. I used to sing on the Gospel Choir and the Volunteer Choir years ago. I also listen to the Word of God on gospel channels during the week. I can't wait to go to into the new church, it will be overwhelming. I am so happy that the Lord has allowed me to see the new building."

She later met and married the late Willie L. Manning. She retired from Stella

Maris Hospice and continued to work in private duty until the age of 87.

She leaves to cherish her memory: her two daughters, Rubi Shaw-Williams of Vancouver, WA and Darlene Manning of Newtown, VA; son, James A. Washington of Baltimore; six grandchildren, five great-grandchildren and a host of neices, nephews, other relatives and friends.

Those who preceded her in death are: seven brothers, Nathaniel, Charlie, Eugene, James, Joseph, Peter and Alton; and two sisters, Rosana and Meredith
