Our beloved Suzanne Marsha Tucker, 38 years old, passed away on Friday, February 14, 2014, after a life filled with endless laughter and love. She was born in Annatto Bay St. Mary, Jamaica West Indies on October 13, 1975 to Verley Gohagen and Arthur Bhagwandat. She was preceded in death by the grandparents whom she loved very much.

She accepted Christ at an early age and was united with Mt. Olive Baptist Church.

Susanne received her formal education from Brooklyn Technical School in New York and graduated from Hermitage High School in Henrico, County, Virginia. She furthered her education at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, Averrett University and received her MPA at Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

She met her best friend and the love of her life, Danon Tucker in high school and married him in Jamaica on August 5, 1999. Their union was blessed with two children. Suzanne's passion was helping others which she demonstrated in her professional career in Human Resources and Management. She began her career at an early age at Food Lion, progressing in responsibility as
