She attended a teacher training in Trinidad, Growing up in Trinidad meant that the community was relatively tight knit. When as a teacher she met her future husband , Carlton Bethelmy Redhead. The couple was married on April 2, 1951. The couple had eight children spanning 20 years, Firstborn was Robert , Kenny, Lydia, (deceased July 7, 2007), Russell, Lynnett, Stanton, Kenton and Lima. She lived for her children her children were everything.

Working outside of the home was rare. She worked at the International Food Limited in Trinidad for a few years. In 1988, she immigrated to the U.S. And began working at the Hilton Hotel and later Rosewood Center in Reisterstown, She then worked as a health aide assisting many home bound individuals as her children were grown and left home. As a West Indian mother, it was hard to let go of her involvement in her children and grandchildren lives. After her husband died April, 1994 her ongoing health problems began. She initially lived with her son Russell who attended to some of her medical issues, She then lived with her sister Joan in New Jersey for short while before

permanently moving in with her second daughter Lynnett in 2009. She joined the Hopkin Elder Plus Center. There she became active and an observer of the various activities. She enjoyed bingo, shopping with the other participants but was very much interested in the Thanksgiving Luncheon and the Crab feast held at the facility each year. She enjoyed having her great grandchildren come to the house and pretend to give her insulin injections, or using her cane as a guitar or walker as the parallel bars.

Five of Sylvia's siblings preceded her in death: Cynthia, Milton, Roy, Errol, Acklin and Alan.
