SYMERA POWELL ANDERSON, stepped on board the Ship of Zion on January 29, 2009. Symera was born on May 2, 1919 in Aulander, North Carolina to the late Thomas and Edna Powell. She was raised in Bertie County, North Carolina and graduated from C. G. White High School in Powellsville, North Carolina.
