with a purchased gift. Keira also enjoyed participating in Special Olympics Basketball and was sure to make friends everywhere she went. Keira mixing her Crystal Light packets in the bottled water she brought from home and applying her Bath and Body Works products during programming will be moments missed by her friends

Keira was tremendously loved by her family which was apparent by how sneakers and outfits were always coordinated, her hair styled, and how involved her mother, father and step-father were with helping many of her day to day desires and big dreams become reality. Keira having the opportunity to meet celebrity Chris Brown was one of the most unforgettable times in her life as it meant so much to her.
