



## Tamene Gezahegn Dilnesahu

August 6, 1967 - December 10, 2017

Tamene Gezahegn Dilnesahu, was born to his father Gezahegn Dilnesahu and his mother Birke Chala, on August 6, 1967 in the town of Shashemene, Ethiopia. He attended elementary school at Atse Naod, followed by middle and high school at the comprehensive school in Shashemene. Tamene subsequently moved to Bahir -Dar to enroll in the Poly-Technical school to study Agro-mechanics, from which he graduated with distinction. After graduation, he was employed by Ambo College of Agriculture as an instructor and taught there for three years. Tamene was always ambitious and aspired to higher education. In 1989 he was awarded a scholarship to study Mechanical Engineering in the Czech Republic. While there, he received his Master's degree and met his future wife, Pavla. In 1997, Tamene came to the United States where he and Pavla would be blessed by the arrival of their daughters, Sarah and Anna Dilnesahu. Tamene was employed as an Engineer at the Maryland Department of the Environment where he was universally respected and admired by his coworkers for his perpetual smile and gracious personality. During the same period of time, Tamene also taught several mathematics courses at the Department of Mathematics and Engineering at Baltimore City Community College. Tamene's warmth and gift for sharing knowledge made him a natural and effective teacher.

Tamene was kind, loving, respectful and generous, not only as a husband and father, but to any and all who were fortunate enough to know him. His involvement and devotion to his family included not only his own daughter's

school work, but their love of sports, where Tamene coached, volunteered and encouraged their efforts. Tragically taken from us on Sunday December 10, 2017, Tamene will be missed dearly by all who knew him.
