TAMMY ELIZABETH WALTERS, daughter of the late Pearlie H. McGee and Naomi McGee, was born August 15, 1961 in Baltimore, Maryland. She was the oldest of four children. James Allen McGee preceded her in death in March, 2001.

After a lengthy illness, Tammy peacefully slipped into eternal rest on Thursday, August 6, 2015 at her home.

Tammy attended Dunbar Senior High School and graduated in 1979. She furthered her education at Coppin State University, from which she graduated with a degree in Applied Science and Nursing.

Tammy was baptized at Providence Baptist Church on Pennsylvania Avenue. As she grew and became closer to Christ Tammy joined Ray of Hope Baptist Church where she sang on the CM Franklin Choir.

Tammy was employed at Montebello Rehabilitation Center in Baltimore, Maryland from 1985 until they closed the facility down. Tammy was later employed by Kernan Hospital. Her sense of humor, friendliness and caring nature created a pleasant, comfortable atmosphere among co-workers. Tammy was often described as being knowledgeable and resourceful in carrying out her job responsibilities.
