Terence Lee Jefferson, the son of Larcenia Jefferson and the late Donald Lee Jefferson, was born on April 2, 1963. Terence, "Jeff" as he was often called, departed this life on January 11, 2016 after battling a long illness. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Kenneth Earl Daniels and Marvin Stepney.

Terence was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. He worked for the Social Security Administration as a Teleservice Representative and Union Representative for the American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE) Local 1923. Terence was full of life and never let his disability stop him from living a full life after his accident that left him disabled on August 3, 1978. He was easy to talk to, straight forward and most of all, he was a fighter. He was baptized at the Holy Covent Church of Baltimore, MD on May 3, 1993.
