Terrance graduated from Henrico High School, where he spent three years as a drum major for the Mighty Warriors Marching Band. Terrance also studied theater for three years at Henrico County Center for the Arts. He gained a lot of his dance training while performing in The Nutcracker Sweet for two years. Terrance wanted to become a professional performer. He landed a role as a Scarecrow in the Busch Garden’s Jack is Back. Terrance also performed in the plays Pippin, Newbies, Cinderella, The Addams Family and Once on this Island.

Terrance was preceded in death by his grandfather, John Pleasants and grandmother, Betty Jean Pleasants.
