Terrell Garnett, son of Paul I. Garnett, Sr. and Mary E. Garnett was born April 13, 1948 in Shacklefords, Virginia. He entered eternal rest on All Saints Day, October 31, 2018.

Terrell was preceded in death by his wife, Pamela R. Garnett, and parents, Paul and Mary Garnett.

Terrell accepted the Lord as his personal savior at an early age. He was baptized and became a member of the First Baptist Church of Hockley.

He received his education in the West Point and King & Queen County Public School Systems. Terrell excelled academically and received the "I Dare You Award" upon graduation from Central High School. This award was given to young people to achieve their full potential and influence others. Following graduation, Terrell attended Norfolk State College and majored in Political Science. He possessed the "Gift of Gab" and had a talent for verbal fluency and spoke persuasively.

Terrell enlisted in the United States Coast Guard on November 30, 1972 and was honorably discharged on June 29, 1978. While serving in the USCG, Terrell was assigned to the Department of Transportation and was stationed in Nova Scotia at CFB Halifax Military Base. Upon returning to Virginia, he

served in Yorktown, Virginia. During his time of service, Terrell received the National Defense Metal.

When his father became ill, Terrell served as his caregiver for several years. During his leisure time, Terrell could be found playing poker and socializing with friends, who referred to him as "Big T."
