He served from first grade through seventh grade. During this time he also served and participated in the "Just Say No to Drugs Program," in each learning leadership and survival skills. He was always bringing someone home to grandma's home to eat. He loved everyone and everyone loved him. He loved rap music and played it often and loud. There was one rapper he loved so much, he nicknamed himself after him, "Murda." Pretty soon it became his signature. He loved and was devoted to his family. He will be dearly missed by

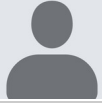
