Theodore attended Bonny National Grammar School Bonny. Pa Theodore Victor Allison struggled and passed his Secondary school leaving Certificate (WAEC). He left for Lagos in Nigeria and worked briefly in a Commercial bank. After

gathering some money to further his education, Pa Theodore Victor Allison left the shores of Nigeria to United States of America in 1982, when he was 27 years.

He graduated from A & M University Huntsville Alabama with first degree and Masters.

Pa Theodore Victor Allison got married to his divorced wife Diana and was blessed with two children TJ and Dianna. Pa Theodore Victor Allison moved from Alabama to Boston and later to Maryland USA. He got married again in Maryland to Marsha. The marriage was a blissful one. They both lived together in Maryland before moving to Los Angeles California in 2021. Pa Theodore Victor Allison was a caring person, kind, and a cheerful giver. He lived a good life with his step children Jason, Jonathan and Steven. Even with his mother in law Mama Janet Ramsahai.
