Theodore M. Haskins, affectionately known as "Teddy," was born on April 28th, 1949, to the late Theodore Haskins Sr. and Reverend Cecilia Frazier. He departed this life on April 21st, 2026. Theodore lived in Baltimore, MD for a short time and he later relocated to Harlem, New York with his father, where he attended school. Teddy graduated high school and pursued a long-time dream of singing.

He joined The Admirations in 1968. Theodore enjoyed traveling with Kenny, Barry, Jerry, and Derryck while they performed in front of large crowds all over New York. As that time came to an end, Teddy ventured out to find his career. He entered the New York City Police Force, where he served faithfully for many years. He received many awards along with an accommodation for being instrumental in solving a murder that occurred on the subway.

Teddy relocated to Baltimore, Maryland in the mid-1990s, where he became a dedicated member of the Baltimore City Sheriff's Department. During his service, he worked closely with judges, court staff, and fellow officers, earning the respect of all who encountered him. His outgoing personality, combined with the genuine care and concern he showed for others, made it clear that he was destined for greater impact.

In time, Teddy became the lead liaison between the Sheriff's Office and the

Baltimore Public School Division. In this role, he embraced the responsibility of mentoring and supporting young people, leaving a lasting impression on countless lives.

He was preceded in death by his brother, Pastor Richard Phillips, and his longtime friend, Michael Alford.

Teddy leaves to cherish his memory: one loving daughter, Tayana Rich Wade; one son, Antonio Rodriguez, and five grandchildren—Cordell Fletcher of Chicago, Illinois; Tyler Fletcher of Atlanta, Georgia; Taylor Fletcher of Douglasville, Georgia; Tyre Fletcher and Teyon Ward of Huntsville, Alabama. He is also survived by seven great-grandchildren: Asharia Fletcher, Cajuan Fletcher, Kylani Fletcher, Tylani Fletcher, August Fletcher, Kailee Fletcher, and Cali Fletcher. He will be fondly remembered by two nieces, two nephews, and a host of other family and friends. His favorite cousin, Vera Ford; his sister in Christ, Rhonda Wilson; his special son, Berry Ford; devoted life-long friend; Robin Simms and his devoted friends, Antionette Inkoom, Marsha Beckett, Harriet R. Johnson and Ulanda Russ.
